STEP 1: KNOW YOUR INSTITUTIONAL RESOURCES

Check whether your institution has an India strategy or initiative. Our database provides information on dozens of U.S. institutions already engaging with India. You can learn from them too!



STEP 3: MATCH-MAKING AND PARTNER SEARCH

STEP 5: DO YOUR DUE DILIGENCE

Which rankings or accreditation can you consider? What third party legal or tax advice might you need?
